DeLauro Announces \$1.3 Million Federal Grant for Continuum of Care

NEW HAVEN, Conn. – Congresswoman Rosa L. DeLauro (Conn.-3) today announced a federal grant in the amount of \$1,394,600 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for Continuum of Care, Inc. of New Haven. The funding was administered under the Section 811 program, which provides funding to nonprofit organizations to build, acquire, or rehabilitate rental housing with supportive service for persons with disabilities. Continuum of Care will use the funding to renovate ten units that will house approximately 14 very low-income individuals with developmental disabilities.

“For over 40 years, Continuum of Care has provided safe and affordable shelter to persons with disabilities. This grant will allow them to continue that tradition by providing the resources for much-needed renovations,” said DeLauro. “I congratulate Continuum of Care for being awarded this competitive grant and look forward to the housing renovations that will be completed with this funding.”

“This is a wonderful day for advocates and beneficiaries of permanent supportive housing for people with disabilities in the New Haven Community,” said Patti Walker CEO & President of Continuum of Care, Inc. “Continuum of Care is grateful to all the members of our Connecticut Delegation who supported our proposal to HUD to provide safe and affordable housing to people with disabilities.”
